Beware of suspicious links

Clicking on unfamiliar links can result in your accounts being compromised. We encourage Members to:

'Stop and think, don't click the link!'.

It doesn't matter if you quickly close out of a window. It doesn't matter if you only take a quick peek and don't touch anything else while you're on a risky webpage. Often, just clicking on a single link can compromise your device, online privacy, and even your identity.

Suspicious links can often be circulated via social media.

Here are some important tips for social media safety:

- Be cautious with friend requests; they could be fake accounts, even if they seem familiar.
- Be careful when clicking on links, as social media accounts can be hacked. Watch for unusual language or content that doesn't sound like your friend.
- Enable Two-Factor Authentication on your social media accounts and set them to private. This adds an extra layer of protection against identity theft.
- Be mindful of what you share online. Avoid disclosing sensitive personal information like your home address, financial details, or phone number.
